Alfredo was a stranger to nobody and made friends with everyone who simply smiled back. He was always willing to help others in need and graciously welcomed anybody with his kind and warming personality. He was short man with a big heart and a kind caring soul that will be deeply missed by everyone who knew him; however, he will never be
