Ronni Sue Kreikemeier (32) died unexpectedly on October 15, 2021 in her home in Fort Collins, Colorado. His free-spirited personality will continue to bring joy to the family, allowing Ronni's memory to carry on through her children.

Those who knew Ronni know that life dealt her a difficult hand. Trauma and addiction were a part of her life from the beginning, and she worked very hard to overcome their grip. Her family and friends are incredibly proud of the steps she had made in recent years to heal herself and chart a new path forward for her children. Ronni will be remembered as a lover of animals, a kind and supportive friend, and a beloved mother.

Ronni is survived by her children: Chloe, Kayden, and Tucker; her siblings: Tracy (Chris), Jerad, Michelle, Shana (Doug), and Jennifer; her father: Glen Kreikemeier; and many nieces and nephews. Ronni is preceded in death by her mother, Rose Kreikemeier; and grandparents Francis Wortmann and Art and Berniece Kreikemeier.
