Alyce Florence Pire, age 93, left her physical body behind when she passed away on May 29, 2016.

During her marriage, she raised two children and helped support and manage her husbands' restaurant and insurance businesses. Alyce also obtained her Private Pilot's License and flew with him on many trips in the company aircraft.

She read the Bible daily and passed along this devotion and dedication to God to her family and friends, providing them with inspiration and desire to do their best to serve the Lord.
