Andrew Michael Darsky, 36, of Reno, Nevada, died July 23, 2009 at Renown Hospital, in Reno, Nevada. Mr. Darsky was born on May 19, 1973 in Orange, New Jersey to Richard J. Darsky and Sharon E. Cullen Darsky. Andrew and his family moved to Greeley, Colorado in 1978. He graduated from University High School in Greeley in 1991 and attended AIMS Community College. Andrew married Sara Nicole Cox on September 18, 1999 in Greeley. For the past three years, Andrew worked in human resource management at Jarden Corporation in Reno.
