She overcame many struggles in her life, but that's what made her strong in hard times.

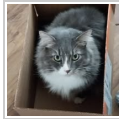
She will be so missed and was, and always will be loved and never forgotten.

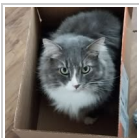

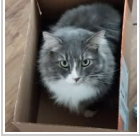
