TEAM BILL Bill Jubert, 52, of Bellvue, passed peacefully at Poudre Valley Hospital on October 11, 2010, from complications of meningococcal meningitis. He fought the effects of the disease for four months with the support of his wife and two daughters. He fought hard to overcome this disease, survived it and actually was released from the hospital and made it home for four days before other complications arose.
