Carl Clifton Gotti was born November 10, 1984 in Nacogdoches, TX. He was a 2003 graduate of Nacogdoches High School and earned a Bachelor of Animal Science degree from Stephen F. Austin State University in 2007. He married his first love, Bénédicte Sohier, in 2008 and they have two beautiful children together – Ethan Gotti (6) and Clara Gotti (4). He was employed with the City of Loveland as a Water Specialist. Carl passed away on Saturday, September 28, 2019 in Fort Collins, Colorado. 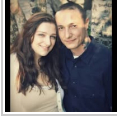
