He enrolled at Colorado State University where he earned his Bachelor of Fine Arts degree, concentrating in Sculpture and Metalsmithing/jewelry Design. His work can be found in public and private collections across the U.S. As an avid reader, his lifelong learning was the wisdom and master of, not all, but most trades. From teaching leather craft to the 4-H club to sharing his stained glass skills with others. His spirit will be missed.

Surviving are his wife, Deanna; son, Christopher; daughter, Lea McKibben and four wonderful grandchildren: Kristen, Kaitlyn, Kaylee and Jack.

He was preceded in death by his parents, a bother, Clyde Weaver, Jr.; two sisters, Jacqueline Barton Weber, and Lorraine Backus.

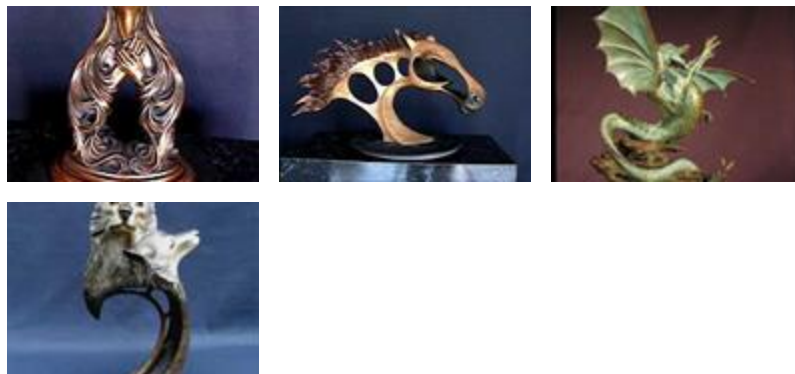
