Chester "Chet" M. Stoskopf Jr., 76, of Fort Collins, died Dec. 11, 2005, at Poudre Valley Hospital. Mr. Stoskopf Jr. was born July 25, 1929, in Great Bend, Kan., to Chester M. Stoskopf Sr. and Georgia Louise Owen Stoskopf. Chet worked in the oil fields in Kansas then enlisted in the Navy. After serving in the Navy from 1948 to 1952 during the Korean War, he stayed and worked as an aircraft mechanic in San Diego.
