Christopher Ryan Brown passed away at his home in Walden, Colorado, on December 7, 2025, with the love of his life, Cami Cordray, by his side.

Chris was born on October 22, 1985, in Denver, Colorado. His family moved to Walden in October of 1993. Chris attended the North Park Schools. He graduated in 2004 from North Park High School. He spent most of his life in Walden, a place he always considered his home.

Chris enlisted and served in the Army from February 14, 2007, through June 10, 2010. He served in Iraq and received the Army Achievement Medal for exceptionally meritorious service while assigned to Hawk Company as a team leader and vehicle commander. SPC Brown's hard work, dedication, attention to detail, and selfless service greatly contributed to the successful accomplishment of the Unit's mission.
