Coke went on his last ride on April 2, 2007, after a lengthy illness. He was born April 6, 1951. He was an avid biker since the early 1970s, spending his last 10 years with the Sons of Silence MC. Coke joined the Army in May 1969 and served in Vietnam 1969-1970. He was a tow truck driver in the Fort Collins area for the past 20 years, owning Blue Sky Towing since 1995.
