David B. Thompson, 86, of Fort Collins, died August 27, 2009 at Fort Collins Health Care. During the first years of their marriage they took ownership of the Electric Shoe Shop and in 1978 purchased Clarkes Hallmark which they enjoyed running together for many years. During their 46 years of marriage they enjoyed their many friends, camping in the Snowy Range in Wyoming, golfing, and traveling in their 5th wheel trailer. David enjoyed painting and photography. He loved music and dancing. He loved people and seemed to be fascinated with them. He always had a kind word and loved to make people smile. He was a good friend to many along the way and always made an impression.
