



## Edward R. Boyer

September 18, 1921 - May 10, 2014

Edward R. Boyer, 92 of Fort Collins, passed away a local nursing home. Edward was born September 18, 1921 on a farm North of Fort Collins to Jake and Kathryn Boyer. He attended school in Buckeye, Colorado and joined the Army Air Force in 1941 as an air plane mechanic but ended up serving as a supply truck driver. He served in Tripoli where he viewed the pyramids and landed on Omaha beach driving a truck off a barge in the conflict. His numerous stories include meeting General Patton and how he ended up driving supply trucks to the front lines. He returned to Fort Collins where he met and married Lois M. Marks on March 26, 1945 in Laramie, Wyoming. Ed worked for Black's Glass for 40 years and enjoyed fishing, camping and vacations with his family, gambling trips to Black Hawk, Deadwood and Wendover, and shopping with his wife. He was able to go on the Honor Flight to Washington DC in 2010 and visit the WWII memorial which was a special event in his life. He was very proud to serve his country and considered it an honor and a privilege. Ed is survived by his sons, Charles E. Boyer of Fort Collins and Duane R. Boyer wife Linda of Piru, California; two granddaughters, Patti Sherry husband Patrick of Longmont, CO and Julie Dawson husband Patrick of Fort Collins; two step-granddaughters, Lisa and Karen of California, and six great grandchildren. He was a devoted husband, loving father and caring individual to all of his friends, nephews, nieces, aunts, uncles and cousins. 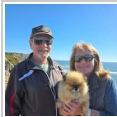
