



## Fay Geraldine Fluck

August 1, 1922 - October 20, 2009

After suffering debilitating illness for many years, Fay Geraldine Day Fluck, born August 1, 1922 in Coats, Kansas, died October 20, 2009 in Fort Collins, Colorado. Geraldine grew up in Pratt, Kansas, where she spent much of her adult life supporting herself and her parents by working in the hotel and retail industries.
