Geraldine K. "Jerry" Mihelich, 90, of Fort Collins, died November 14, 2009 at McKee Hospice. Jerry was born April 12, 1919 in Pueblo, Colorado to Anton and Mary Kolbezen. She married Anthony "Ginger" Mihelich on October 16, 1948 in Pueblo, Colorado. Ginger passed away June 8, 1998. Jerry and Ginger moved to the Fort Collins area in 1980 from Pueblo. She was a homemaker and retired state employee. Jerry graduated Summa Cum Laude with a degree in Science from the College of Mt. St. Joseph on the Ohio, Cincinnati, Ohio on June 5, 1942. Jerry was an affiliate of the Marianists, and also a Eucharist Minister and Lector at St Joseph Catholic Church in Fort Collins. She loved to cross stitch, read, knit and garden. Survivors include her daughter, Trisha Tom Jones of Fort Collins; son, Don Becky Mihelich and one grandson, Michael all of Webster Grove, Missouri; and numerous nieces, nephews and their families.
