



## Harold Allan Al Sampson

Harold Allan AL Sampson, 75, passed away Aug. 8, 2008. Al was born Feb. 25, 1933, in Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio, to Harold and Doris Sampson. Al served in the US Army 1951-1954, 73rd Tank Battalion, including fifteen months in Korea. On Sept. 2, 1956, he married his lifelong love, Clara May Bryner. He loved helping Clara with all of her projects throughout the years. And above all else, loved his family. His funeral will be held at 2 p.m. Thursday at Bohlender Funeral Chapel. Interment will
