October 2, 1927 - March 29, 2015

Hazel Eileen (Enoch) Dixon passed away March 29, 2015 at age 87. Hazel was born October 2, 1927 in Colorado Springs, Colorado to Loran and Etta Enoch. Hazel was one of seven children, including one sister, Lola and five brothers, Martin (Frank), Melvin, John, Arthur, and Virgil.

Hazel grew up in the Drennan community near Colorado Springs, attending the small 2 room Drennan School along with her future husband Howard. Hazel enjoyed playing sports while in school, including playing on the softball and basketball teams. Hazel graduated from Drennan School in 1945 with a class of four.

Hazel married Howard Dixon on April 4, 1948 in Colorado Springs. Howard and Hazel lived on dairy farms near the Drennan community until 1961 when they moved to Rainbow River Ranch in the Laramie River Valley, Glendevy, Colorado, where they ranched for the next 16 years. While on the ranch, Hazel was often the only “hired hand” around to help Howard with the running of the ranch. She somehow managed to work outside all day with the ranch chores, and then go inside and make a delicious meal for hired hands and family, all while raising five children and keeping the house clean. Hazel always had a fresh loaf of homemade bread on the counter ready to serve with every meal, and a cup of coffee ready for anyone walking in the door.

After moving to Bellvue in 1977, Hazel worked in the cafeteria at Woodward Governor for 13 years, retiring in 1990. Hazel loved working in the garden and yard, and was always the central hub for organizing family get-togethers where she enjoyed seeing her many grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and great-great-grandchildren.

Howard and Hazel had five children, Diana (Kasinger), Kathy (Gallegos), Connie (Maas), Richard, and Debbie. Hazel was proud to be grandma to ten grandchildren, seventeen great-grandchildren, and four great-great-grandchildren.

Hazel was preceded in death by her parents, Loran and Etta Enoch, and her five brothers.

A Memorial Service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 7, 2015 at Bohlander Funeral Chapel.
