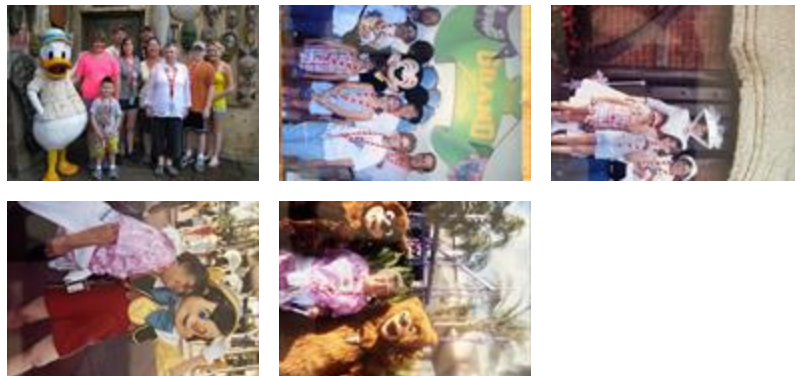
Who ever knew my mother loved her. She was so sweet, but if she didn't like you she would tell you. She was so feisty and full of life in her younger years.

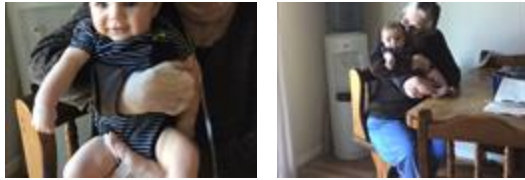
