Jack Curtis Wyman, 73, passed away on September 8, 2016. He was born on April 1, 1943, in Charleston, South Carolina, to Curtis and Edythe Wyman. The family moved to Eureka, Kansas, when he was three. Jack met his wife, Pamela, when he was 17 and she was 14, while swimming in a river.
