Mrs. Joan (Vogel) Pease, 90, of Fort Collins, Colo., passed away early Sunday, March 22, 2020 at Columbine West in Fort Collins.

school for a short time, she ventured down to Fort Collins where she pursued some graduate coursework and subsequently accepted a position with Woodward Governor in Fort Collins, where she worked in several areas for many years until she retired.

Her passing will leave a tremendous void in the lives of her family, friends and co-workers. She was a farm girl with incredible strength, and determination who endured a number of health issues in the latter part of her life. She never missed an opportunity to show a kindness to others in spite of many medical battles she fought and still excelled at everything she tackled.
