John Robert Gallatin, 35, of Sheridan, WY, was killed in an auto crash on November 12, 2017. His wife, Amanda Gallatin and their dog Sadie, survived.

John was born November 12, 1982, in Fort Collins, CO. A 2001 Fort Collins High School graduate, John earned a Civil Engineering Degree from CSU. He worked several years for the US Forest Service/White River National Forest, and in 2014 accepted a position as an Air Quality Engineer working for Wyoming Department of Environmental Air Quality in Sheridan, WY. He and Amanda married on April 4, 2014.

John was a genuine and caring man who loved his wife, his family, and the Lord. Their dog Sadie brought him joy and he was a good 'dad' to her. Training her to sit, stay, shake, give hugs and kisses. He and Amanda enjoyed hiking and shooting guns.

John is survived by his wife, Amanda Gallatin of Sheridan, WY; parents, Sherman and Mary Louise Gallatin of Fort Collins, CO; sister, Suzanne (Aren) Peter of Laramie, WY.
