May your family be blessed, safe and pick up where you left off.

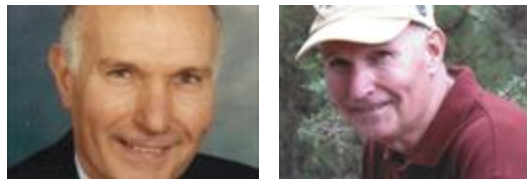
