Josephine Lind, 83, of Fort Collins, passed away May 27, 2007. She is survived by her son, Jackson Lind, Mesa, Ariz.; two sisters, Jean Graham, Fort Scott, Kan., Billie Swope, Cortez; seven grandchildren and 13 great-grandchildren.
