Josephine P. Trujillo, 95, of Fort Collins, died Feb. 16, 2009, at her residence. Mrs. Trujillo was born Jan. 25, 1914, in La Garita, to Joseph J. Curby and Della Valdeze Curby. Josephine married Andrew Trujillo on April 3, 1929 in Creede. After moving from LaGarita, to Fort Collins, in 1940, she lived in LaPorte, for 25 years and eventually moved back to Fort Collins. Much of her working career was spent in Woolworth's as a cashier and with Hesteds as a departmental manager. Josephine's life was intertwined with the love of her family and her paramount belief in her religious teachings. Her faith and love was freely given to everyone she came in contact with.
