Juanita C. Skelton, 93, of Bell-vue, died Jan. 13, 2007, at a local nursing home. Mrs. Skelton was born July 8, 1913, in Groom, Texas, to Fred Hale Campbell and Tuny Gertrude Hughes Campbell. Juanita married Hiram Bowmer Skelton on March 12, 1944, in Amarillo, Texas. She was the first director of special education for Arlington Public School Systems in Arlington, Texas, and also taught special education. She then moved to Fort Collins in 1995 from Arlington, Texas. She was a member of First United Methodist Church, Retired Teachers, Chamber of Commerce and the Women's Club.
