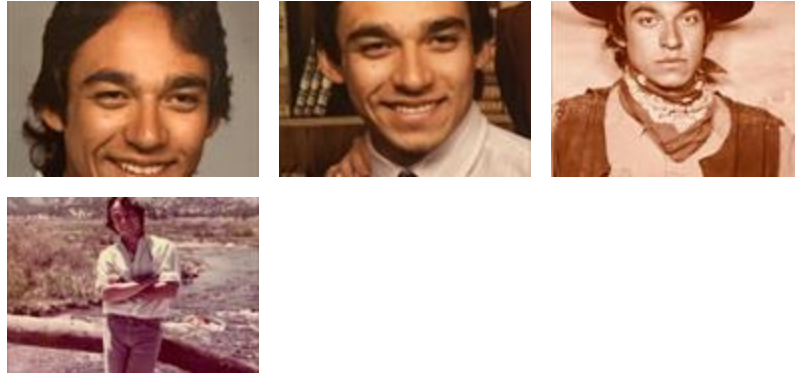

“ *I only knew Kerry for a short time.*

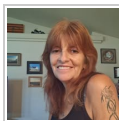
He would often call me at 3:00 AM, to tell me about how much he loved his daughter!
