Kervyn P. Bradley, 88, of 3300 Stanford Road, Fort Collins, passed away Sept. 9, 2005, after a brief illness. Kervyn was born July 16, 1917, in Akron, Iowa. Soon after graduating from high school in Akron, he began farming full time in Union County, S.D. He married the former Colleen Dannenbring on June 1, 1940.
