Lillian P. Sloan, beloved mother and grandmother went home to Heaven, Oct. 4, 2008. She was born July 22, 1918, to Ernest and Ella "Synder" Tonniges of Gresham, Neb. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Paul's Lutheran Church northeast of Gresham. She attended the parochial school at St. Paul's and later attending Gresham High School.
