Our beloved Husband, Daddy, Dad, Big Pa, Gramps, Grandpa, PaPaw, Poppy, Jones went home to be with his Savior, Jesus, on Dec. 30, 2008. He was 86 years young. Lloyd was born in New Liberty, Mo., to Silas and Myrtle Jones on Feb. 18, 1922. He was one of nine children and grew up on the family farm in Missouri. At the age of 15 he began what was a lifelong love of the timber business. He cut and hauled his last load of logs at age 85. He loved the mountains of Colorado and when he moved to Fort Collins in 1946 he knew he was home. It was this home where he and his wife, Eileen, raised their family of four daughters. To his girls he was known as "Daddy" and to his seven grandchildren he was known as "Gramps", "Grandpa", "Big Pa" and "PaPaw". He served in Europe and North Africa. He was awarded three Purple Hearts, Sharpshooter Medal and various other medals. Lloyd was preceded in death by his wife of 50 years, Eileen; a son, Lloyd Wayne; his parents, three brothers, three sisters and many other loved ones.
