Marlin Dean Glantz, 85, of Fort Collins, Colorado died Thursday, December 1, 2022 at Poudre Valley Hospital.

Marlin Glantz was born January 3, 1937 at St. Rose Hospital, Great Bend, Barton County, Kansas to Ella Joanne (Bartel) and Clarence John Glantz of LaCross, Kansas.

The family moved to Loveland, CO in 1945. Marlin graduated from Loveland High School, 1955. He attended the University of Colorado (Boulder) and Colorado State University before moving to Ogden, Utah, where he worked as an accountant and met and married the mother of his children, Janet Elizabeth (Baird) Mott in 1963 before moving to Fort Collins in 1964. After that, Marlin (Glantz Construction) built many custom homes in the Fort Collins area.

Marlin served in the Air Force at Hill AFB (Utah) and in the Air National Guard (Wyoming), 1960-1964.

In retirement, he enjoyed camping, RV-ing, traveling and meeting his friends for morning coffee at The Breakfast Club.
