Nancy Ann Lee, 66, of Fort Collins, CO, died August 23, 2017 at Good Samaritan Fort Collins. Ms. Lee was born September 17, 1950 in Monroeville, AL to James J. Lee, Jr. and Francis Ouida Giles Lee.

Nancy graduated from WP Davidson High School in 1968 where she was a cheerleader and was honored as Homecoming Queen during her senior year. After graduation, Nancy married her high school sweetheart, James Judson Sanders. She earned a degree in English Literature from the University of South Alabama in 1974. While living in Mobile, AL, Nancy married her second husband Robert Michael Tinnin. During this time, she worked in pharmaceutical sales and then the emerging computer industry where she earned many sales awards.

In 1990, Nancy moved to Fort Collins, CO and began her career in radio advertising sales. She later transitioned into hosting her own radio show "Lights On" with Nancy Lee. For over ten years, Nancy interviewed many of the leading voices in New Thought and Spirituality. She spent the last two years of her radio career broadcasting on the Healthy Life Network out of Los Angeles, CA.

Nancy was the author of *Voices of Light*, a book based on her many outstanding interviews and a second book that was co-authored with her sister Cecelia. Nancy was a well-known lecturer, teacher and counselor

whose huge heart and wisdom affected the lives of too many people to mention.

Nancy is survived by her daughter, Katherine Lee Sanders; her son, Michael Brent Tinnin; grandson, Heath Wolfing; granddaughter, Haley Wolfing; sisters, Cecelia Lee (Tom) Keenan and Kelly Melissa Bell; brother, James Jonathan Lee, III; sister-in-law, Julie Lee; and half-sister Ashley Lee (Robert) Vreeland.

Preceding her in death are her parents, James Jonathan Lee, Jr. and Francis Ouida Giles Lee; and a brother, Michael Claude Lee.

Nancy was an amazing mother, grandmother, sister and friend. Her open heart welcomed many people from every walk of life into her world. Her life was a beautiful example of a life well lived.

Nancy's battle with cancer began in 2003. Over the years she was a shining example of courage and grace under fire. Those of us who loved her will never forget the faith and optimism she presented throughout her long battle.
