Nell Elizabeth Davis (née Clark) passed away January 3, 2019 at age 91. Nell Clark was born January 16, 1927 in Ashville, North Carolina to Ralph and Rose Clark. She graduated from Bent County High School in LaJunta, Colorado in 1945 and attended the University of Denver. On June 23, 1946, she married Charles (Chuck) Davis in Fort Lyon, Colorado. They were married for 58 years.
