Pamela Sue Richard Becker Kuenneke, 80, passed away peacefully May 16th, 2026, and entered the arms of her Savior. She had a brief struggle with leukemia and long battle with dementia and passed away in Loveland, Colorado.

She did a lot of Bible studies and was in a biblical school for several years and graduated from that, of which she was very proud. She was a faithful member of the Catholic Church her entire life. She also loved sewing, ceramics, crocheting, knitting, and crafts of all types. She enjoyed making something
