Patricia Mae Harmon, 76, of Fort Collins, died May 31, 2005, at Columbine Care Center West. She is survived by her daughter, Linda Harmon, and granddaughter, Emily Harmon, both of Fort Collins; and by her daughter, Judith Harmon Swafford and son-in-law, Patrick Swafford, of Cheyenne, Wyo.
