



Rema Marie Moren

December 7, 1921 - May 12, 2015

Rema Marie (Miller) Moren, 93, passed away on Tuesday morning, May 12, 2015. She was born on December 7, 1921, to George and Beulah Miller in Howe, Oklahoma. She was raised from the age of 5 by her foster parents, Clarence and Zenobia Blagg, whom she considered her true parents.

Rema graduated from Caddo High School, where she was All State on the Caddo HS championship basketball team. She then attended Northeastern State University in Tahlequah, OK to become an elementary school teacher. She taught primary grades in both Arkansas and Oklahoma before marrying her lifelong love, John T. Moren, on July 15, 1948. They moved to Detroit, Michigan to begin their life together, where she also taught school until becoming a mother. She also lived in Indianapolis, Indiana, and Manlius, New York, before returning to Birmingham, Michigan. Rema and John moved to Fort Collins, Colorado, in 1993.

Rema is preceded in death by her parents, 6 brothers, and 3 sisters. She is survived by her husband, John, of 66 years; daughter, Sandy Moren Lindberg (Jeff) of Fort Collins; and grandson Casey Moren Lindberg, of Tucson, AZ. She is also survived by nieces, Susan Moren and Ashlyn Dellenger (Harold); and great-nephew, Jack Dellenger of Florida. She is also survived by many nephews and nieces on the Miller side.

Rema was very athletic – fueled by her early basketball days. She was an avid golfer, swimmer, skier and championship bowler. She was also a gifted needle worker, bridge player, and quilter. Rema always volunteered, serving a range of organizations from schools to the Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts. She was very active in her church, volunteering and serving on numerous boards. The family would like to thank the staff at Clare Bridge for their loving care provided to Rema in her last years.
