Roberto (Robert/Bob) Luis Jaramillo of Fort Collins, Colorado passed away Friday, August 16, 2024, at the age of 81. He was a beloved husband, father, friend and neighbor who will be deeply missed by all who knew him.

Robert was born on September 20, 1942 in Fort Collins, where he lived his entire life. He served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War and was honorably discharged in 1968. He retired from Colorado State University after 32 years as a Baker and incredible cake decorator.
