She expressed often that God had been working on her for quite some time. Her testimony was a powerful tribute to what God's love can do in a person's life, and she was always open to sharing. She was an inspiration to many. Robin had a special presence, and she loved to laugh and share stories. One of her greatest joys was spending time with her granddaughter, Alora. She was

always thinking of new and special things to do with her and was eager to share whenever Alora learned, said or did something new. Alora affectionately referred to her as Nana. She also loved her precious kitties, Boo Boo, Shadow and Cinnamon, who brought her much companionship. Robin was loved deeply and will be missed by her remaining family and dear friends. She leaves behind daughters, Corinne Carpenter, of Loveland, Rachael Shannon Gigliotti, of Durham, NC, sister Randi Howard Robinson, of Fort Collins, friend and companion Chris Carpenter of Denver, grandchildren Alora Gravley and Gabriel Gigliotti, and many extended family members.
