Shirlee Shoemaker Reissman, 76, died November 19, 2009 at home. Mrs. Reissman was born, November 10, 1933 at Larimer County Hospital now Poudre Valley Hospital to George and Stella Morgan Shoemaker. Shirlee was a lifelong resident of Fort Collins, Colorado. She graduated from Fort Collins High School in 1952, went on to complete secretarial school, received her LPN in 1955, and later became a licensed surgical assistant and worked for surgeons in Fort Collins.
