



## Suzie Ahn Loader

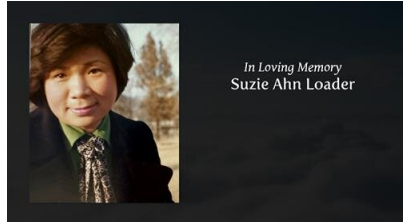
