



## Thomas Edwin Moses

Fort Collins, CO-- Thomas E. (Ed) Moses passed away Tuesday June 14, 2022 in Fort Collins, CO.

Ed was born in Ralls, TX on September 29, 1930 to Lois Tyer Moses and Shirley Arnold Moses. He grew up in East and West Texas before attending Odessa High School where he met his future wife, Beverly Webber.
