Wayne L. Marshall, a World War II veteran of the Air Force and a 28-year resident of Fort Collins, passed away at the age of 84 on Memorial Day, May 29, 2006. Wayne was born in Cleghorn, Iowa, May 2, 1922 to Derius and Minnie Marshall. Wayne married Maurine Deitering, of Bancroft, Iowa in 1941. Wayne and Maurine resided in Fort Dodge, Iowa where Wayne retired from Northwestern Bell Telephone Company in 1978. Upon retirement, the couple relocated to Fort Collins to be closer to family.
